- 2:11- Ex 4:9 11 This beginning of miracles did Yahshua in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.
- 2:12- Mt 13:55-56 12 ¶ After this he went down to Capernaum, he, and his mother, and his brothers, and his disciples: and they continued there not many days.
- 2:13- Ex 12:11 13 And the Jews' passover was at hand, and Yahshua went up to Jerusalem,
- 2:14- De 14:26 14 And found in the temple those that sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the changers of money sitting:
- 15 And when he had made a whip of small cords, he drove them all out of the temple, and the sheep, and the oxen; and poured out the changers' money, and overthrew the tables;
- 2:16- Jer 7:11 16 And said to them that sold doves, Take these things away; make not my Father's house a house of merchandise.
- 2:17- Ps 69:9 17 And his disciples remembered that it was written, The zeal of your house has eaten me up.
- 18 Then answered the Jews and said to him, What sign show you to us, seeing that you do these things?
- 2:19- Mt 12:39-40 19 Yahshua answered and said to them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.
- 2:20- Joh 1:14; 2Co 6:16 20 Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and will you raise it up in three days?
- 2:22- Lu 24:7-8 21 But he spoke of the temple of his body.
- 22 When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this to them; and they believed the scripture, and the word which Yahshua had said.
- 2:23- Joe 2:32; Mt 1:21 23 ¶ Now when he was in Jerusalem at the passover, in the feast *day*, many believed in his name, when they saw the miracles which he did.
- 24 But Yahshua did not commit himself to them, because he knew all *men*,
- 2:25- Mt 12:25 25 And needed not that any should testify of man: for he knew what was in man.

John 3

- 3:1- Joh 7:48 3:1 ¶ There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews:
- 3:2- Joh 9:33 2 The same came to Yahshua by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that you do, unless God is with him.
- 3:3- Ro 8:14; 1Pe 1:23; 1Jo 5:1 3 Yahshua answered and said to him, Truly, truly, I say to you, Unless a man is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
- 3:4- 1Co 2:14 4 Nicodemus said to him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?
- 3:5- Isa 44:3; Ac 2:38 5 Yahshua answered, Truly, truly, I say to you, Unless a man is born of water and *of* the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
- 3:6- Joh 4:24; Ro 8:5 6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.
- 3:7- Eph 4:24 7 Marvel not that I said to you, You must be born again.
- 3:8- 1Co 2:11 8 The wind blows where it wants, and you hear the sound thereof, but cannot tell from where it comes, and where it goes: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.
- 9 Nicodemus answered and said to him, How can these things be?

- 10 Yahshua answered and said to him, Are you a master of Israel, and know not these things?
- 3:11- De 29:4 11 Truly, truly, I say to you, We speak that we do know, and testify that we have seen; and you receive not our witness.
- 3:12- 1Co 3:1-2 12 If I have told you earthly things, and you believe not, how shall you believe, if I tell you *of* heavenly things?
- 3:13- Joh 6:46 13 And no man has ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, *even* the Son of man which is in heaven.
- 3:14- Nu 21:8 14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:
- 3:15- Joh 6:47 15 That whoever believes in him should not perish, but have eternal life.
- 3:16- Ro 5:10 16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- 3:17- Isa 49:7 17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.
- 3:18- Joh 5:24 18 He that believes on him is not condemned: but he that believes not is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
- 3:19- Joh 8:12 19 And this is the condemnation, that light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.
- 20 For every one that does evil hates the light, neither comes to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved.
- 21 But he that does truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are done in God.
- 3:21- 1Jo 1:6 22 ¶ After these things came Yahshua and his disciples into the land of Judaea; and there he continued with them, and baptized.
- 3:23- Mt 3:6 23 And John also was baptizing in Aenon near to Salim, because there was much water there: and they came, and were baptized.
- 24 For John was not yet cast into prison.
- 3:24- Mt 14:3 25 Then there arose a question between *some* of John's disciples
- 3:25- Heb 9:13-14 and the Jews about purifying.
- 26 And they came to John, and said to him, Rabbi, he that was with you beyond *the* Jordan, to whom you bear witness, behold, the same baptizes, and all *men* come to him.
- 3:27- Joh 4:10 27 John answered and said, A man can receive nothing, unless it is given him from heaven.
- 28 You yourselves bear me witness, that I said, I am not the Messiah, but that I am sent before him.
- 3:28- Joh 1:20 29 He that has the bride is the bridegroom: but the friend of the bridegroom, which stands and hears him, rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom's voice: this my joy therefore is fulfilled.
- 3:29- Isa 62:5 30 He must increase, but I *must* decrease.
- 3:30- Ps 63:4 31 He that comes from above is above all: he that is of the earth is earthly,
- 3:31- Joh 16:27-28 and speaks of the earth: he that comes from heaven is above all.
- 3:32- Joh 15:15 32 And what he has seen and heard, that he testifies; and no man receives his testimony.
- 33 He that has received his testimony has set to his seal that God is true.
- 3:33- Ro 3:4 34 For he whom God has sent speaks the words of God: for God
- 3:34- Joh 5:26; Joh 7:37-39 gives not the Spirit by measure *to him*.
- 3:35- Mt 28:18 35 The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into his hand.
- 3:36- Joh 3:15-18 36 He that believes on the Son has everlasting life: and he that believes not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God remains on him.
